1. When a worker completes the 4-hour New Miner Intro Course with us you will receive a copy of this form with the first section completed. The worker is then allowed to work "where an experienced miner can observe that the new miner is performing his or her work in a safe manner."

New Miner and Newly-Hired Experienced Miner Training

Introductory Training provided before the miner begins work

(1) An introduction to the work environment, including a visit and tour of the mine. The method of mining or operation utilized must be explained; (2) Instruction on the recognition and avoidance of hazards, including electrical hazards, at the mine; (3) A review of the escape and emergency evacuation plans in effect at the mine and instruction on the firewarning signals and firefighting procedures; and (4) Instruction on the health and safety aspects of the tasks assigned, including the safe work procedures of such tasks, and the mandatory health and safety standards pertinent to such tasks.

QWIK TIP: "COORDINATING RECORDS"

When the New Miner training certificate is complete, look back over the details and coordinate them with your training plan. Each Competent Person must be listed in Section 2 with the correct subject area. Each New Task used as additional training to satisfy the 24 hours must have a Lesson Plan in Section 5. Lastly check to see if the Task is listed in Section 7.

QWIK TIP: "EXPIRATIONS"

The New Miner Training is good for a period of 12 months (to the end of the month in which training was received) from the date the 4-hour New Miner Introduction was conducted.

Once New Miner is completed, it should never have to be repeated. Before going back to work in a mine for your company, the worker will have to complete 8 hours of Refresher Training.
